Break & Enter – Suspicious Vehicle – Fraud Suspect

Between December 23 and 26, 2017, a residence was broken into in the Westeros area of Wetaskiwin County.

A black Lincoln MKS was stolen from the property and the home rummaged through. Several electronic devices were taken as well as credit cards and personal papers.

The stolen credit card was used at several businesses including Millet Fas Gas, Leduc Esso, Wetaskiwin Mac's and other Edmonton area businesses.
