### **Wetaskiwin RCMP Investigate Firearms Offences - Arrest**

Wetaskiwin Alta. - On August 12, 2019 at approximately 1012 hours Wetaskiwin RCMP received a complaint from a male victim who had attended a Wetaskiwin residence to see a male regarding property and that the suspect male pointed a firearm at him. The male victim left location. No injuries were sustained. No rounds were discharged. Subjects are known to each other.

Wetaskiwin City RCMP in conjunction with Wetaskiwin General Investigation Section and Wetaskiwin Crime Reduction Unit completed an investigation. One suspect was later located at the same address and arrested without incident.

Wayne WIEBE (37) of Wetaskiwin has been charged with the following:

- Pointing a Firearm
- Possession of a Weapon for a Dangerous Purpose
- Possession of Firearm when known unauthorized
- Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm
- Careless Use of a Firearm
- Possession of a Controlled Substance
- Fail to comply with conditions of Release (X8)
- Possession of a Firearm contrary to Prohibition Order

Wayne WIEBE was brought before a Justice of the Peace and was remanded and is scheduled to appear in court August 22, 2019.
