



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS OF ALDER FLATS AND BUCK LAKE

RE: RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION

Effective January 14, 2019, residential garbage collection will take place every THURSDAY.

Collection services apply to *Residential Premises only* and do not include the owners and occupants of multi-family residences, apartment houses, commercial, industrial and building projects.

All household waste must be:

- Bagged (plastic garbage bags, not shopping bags or cardboard boxes).
- Contained in either a metal or plastic containers with lids,
 - in a manner to be protected from animals and the wind
- Each household is allowed a maximum of two (2) receptacles
 - not to exceed 121 liters capacity and
 - a maximum of 25 kg (55 lbs) per receptacle,
- Placed at the curb (outside the property line) by 7:00 a.m. on garbage collection day. County employees will not enter private property to collect garbage.

Any waste not meeting the above guidelines will not be picked up.

This pick up is for household waste only and does not include items such as lawn clippings, leaves and trimmings, construction debris or ashes.

Residents will be required to transport all non-household waste to a County operated solid waste transfer site. The nearest transfer site is West Buck Lake Transfer Station located ½ mile south of Highway 13 on Highway 22 then ¼ mile west. The site is open Tuesdays & Saturdays, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
