

BY-LAW NUMBER 2003/31

BY-LAW NO. 2003/31 is a by-law of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 in the Province of Alberta, to authorize a special tax to raise revenue to pay for the anticipated maintenance expenses of the Silver Creek Water Management Project for the 2003 fiscal year.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 382 of the Municipal Government Act, 1994, Chapter M-26.1, and amendments thereto, the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin deems it necessary to levy a special tax to assist in covering the maintenance costs of the Silver Creek Water Management Project.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 383 of the Municipal Government Act the special tax by-law authorizes the Council to impose the Silver Creek Water Management Project tax in respect of property in any area of the municipality that will benefit from the specific services.

WHEREAS the special tax must not be imposed on property that is exempt under section 351 of the Municipal Government Act.

WHEREAS the County of Wetaskiwin's financial share of the yearly amount required to meet the 2003 maintenance expenses for the Silver Creek Water Management Project is \$118.80. There is a flat rate charged to TX Roll 104.00, 137.00, 139.00 and 142.00 of \$1.80/yr which is also included in the requisitioned amount of \$118.80.

NOW THEREFORE under the authority of the Municipal Government Act the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to impose a special Silver Creek Water Management tax levy on the assessed values of properties as shown on the following property:
