

BY-LAW 2003/06

BY-LAW NO. 2003/06 is a by-law of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of the establishing grants to be provided by the county to fire Co-operatives/Departments for fire protection services.

WHEREAS: the Municipal Government Act S.A. 1994c.M-26.1, as amended, provides that a Council of a municipality may pass by-laws for the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property, and for services provided by or no behalf of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS: the Forest and Prairie Protection Act R.S.A. 1980 c. F-14, as amended, provides that the Council of a County is responsible for fighting and controlling all fires within the municipal boundaries;

AND WHEREAS: the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 wishes to establish fire services within the Municipality and to provide for efficient operation of such fire services;

AND WHEREAS: the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has deemed it expedient and desirable to create five Fire Protection Areas in the County;

NOW THEREFORE: the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. A yearly grant will be made available to the following Fire Co-operative/Departments within the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10:
 - (a) East-West Millet Rural Fire Department Society
 - (b) Mulhurst Bay & District Fire Protection Society
 - (c) Winfield & District Fire Cooperative Limited
 - (d) Buck Lake/Alder Flats Fire Association
 - (e) Wetaskiwin Rural Fire Protection Zone 2 Society
2. The yearly grant shall be in the amount as per Schedule A, which may be amended by resolution of council.
3. This grant shall be subject to the following:
 - (a) All conditions provided for in By-laws 98/25 and 98/26 are met; and
 - (b) A Financial Statement for the Fire Department's previous year of operation shall be submitted to the County of Wetaskiwin.
4. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.
5. This By-law repeals By-law 98/44.

READ: A First time this 21st day of January, A.D., 2003.

READ: A Second time this 21st day of January, A.D., 2003.

READ: A Third time and finally passed this 21st day of January, A.D., 2003.
