

## BY-LAWS - 2004

1. For the purpose of an amendment to the Municipal Development Plan which was approved by By-law 98/55.
2. For the purpose of a Text Amendment to the Land Use Bylaw 95/54.
3. A by-law to support, regulate, control, and improve the water and waste water treatment and distribution systems within the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10. (Repeals By-law 90/04 and all amending by-laws thereto.)
4. Borrowing By-law
5. To authorize the cancellation of certain taxes and certain arrears of taxes and penalties which have been cancelled by resolution of Council.
6. To authorize payment of certain monies as grants during the years 2003 certain charitable organizations and institutions and societies in recognition of the benefits received from them.
7. Respecting the Wetaskiwin Memorial Cemetery operated by the City of Wetaskiwin and repealing by-law 98/63.
8. For the purpose of closing to public travel and selling that portion of road allowance adjacent to the west boundary of the NW 2-44-22-W4M, lying south of Road Plan 4071 MC, in exchange for an area 66' wide, located on the north western boundary of the NE 3-44-22-W4M, currently registered through Alberta Land Titles to The Central Alberta Youth Fellowship under Title #812 081 357 B. (Living Springs Bible Camp)
9. For the purpose of amending the Land Use By-law 95/54 by reclassifying Lot 4A, Block 1, Plan 032 1933 in SE 14-46-1-W5M (approximately 1.1 hectares/2.72 acres) from High Density Residential to Urban Residential.
10. For the purpose of amending an Area Structure Plan which was adopted by By-law 97/58; for the purpose of providing a framework for subsequent subdivision and development of the area known as portions of SE 14-46-1-W5M (The Village at Pigeon Lake)
11. For the purpose of a Text Amendment to Land Use By-law 95/54, Schedule B, Sections 1 and 5.
12. To authorize the purchase of capital equipment for use in the various areas of the County operation for the fiscal year 2003.
13. For the purpose of amending the Land Use By-law 95/54 by reclassifying Lot 2, Block 2, Plan 792 2380 in SW 13-46-1-W5M (approximately 0.94 hectares/2.32 acres) from Country Residential to Recreational. (Blackmore)
14. For the purpose of amending the Land Use By-law 95/54 by reclassifying Lot B, Plan 772 1113 in NE 1-47-28-W4M (approximately 8.09 hectares/20 acres) from Agricultural to Watershed Protection. (Widdows)
