COUNSELLING SUBSIDY GUIDELINES

The County will subsidize the percentage of the counselling fee indicated in the fee schedule above, based on the client's gross family income.

The County's contribution is limited to a maximum of \$100 per counselling session.

Any portion of the counselling fee that is not covered by the County subsidy is the responsibility of the client.

Eligible clients may receive a subsidy for up to six (6) counselling sessions per calendar year.

Example: If a client qualifies for a 70% subsidy and the counselling fee is \$100/hour, the County would pay \$70 and the client would pay \$30. If the counselling fee is \$200/hour, the 70% subsidy would be \$140, but the County contribution would be capped at \$100, leaving \$100 for the client.
