



County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 BYLAW # 2026/14

A Bylaw of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of establishing fees, rates and charges for services provided by the municipality.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c. M-26 (the MGA), as amended, provides that a municipality may pass Bylaws for goods and services provided by or on behalf of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS Section 8 of the MGA allows a municipality to pass a Bylaw establishing fees for licenses, permits, and approvals as established by Council, including fees for licenses, permits, and approvals that may be in the nature of a reasonable tax for the activity authorized or for the purpose of raising revenue.

AND WHEREAS Section 8 of the MGA allows a municipality to pass a Bylaw establishing fees for licenses, permits, and approvals that are higher for persons or businesses who do not reside or maintain a place of business in the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the County of Wetaskiwin has been deemed an accredited municipality under the *Safety Codes Act*, and the *Safety Codes Act*, RSA 2000, c. S-1, as amended, authorizes an accredited municipality to make Bylaws respecting fees for anything issued or any material or service provided pursuant to the *Safety Codes Act*.

AND WHEREAS the *Access to Information Act (ATIA)* and *ATIA Regulation*, AR 133/2025, as amended, requires a municipality to make certain information available to the public and authorizes a local public body by Bylaw to set, but not exceed, fees for services as provided for in the ATIA Regulation.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin deems it appropriate to establish fees, rates, and charges for municipal services.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

PART 1 - TITLE

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the "**Fees and Charges Bylaw**".

PART 2 - INTERPRETATION

2. Headings, titles, and margin notes in this Bylaw are for ease of reference only.
3. Every provision of this Bylaw is independent of all other provisions and if any provision of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw shall remain valid and enforceable.
4. References to Bylaws and enactments in this Bylaw include amendments and replacement Bylaws and enactments, and regulations and orders thereunder.

PART 3 - APPLICATION

5. The fees and charges payable for municipal services provided by the County of Wetaskiwin shall be outlined in the following Schedules, attached hereto:

- 6. Should any fees and charges remain unpaid after a thirty (30) day period from the issuance of an invoice, the unpaid amounts will be subject to late payment charges (penalty) of three percent (3%) per month until fully paid.
- 7. The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to reduce any fee set out in any Schedule attached to this Bylaw if an emergency, event, or other circumstance results in a long-term closure or reduction of service related to the fee.
- 8. By resolution of Council, the municipality may set or permit fees, rates, or charges for special circumstances, special items, individual agreements with external agencies, or for an item not established by a Schedule attached to this Bylaw.

PART 4 - REPEAL

- 9. That Bylaw 2024/70, and amending Bylaws 2025/03 and 2025/19, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

PART 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

- 10. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on March 1, 2026.
