Recycling Options:

- E-waste Recycling (TV's, Computers, tablets, printers & accessories, microwaves)
- Paint Recycling (includes aerosols)
- Paper (newspapers, flyers, boxboard, catalogs, magazines, etc.)
- Pesticide Chemical Containers (triple rinsed)
- Agricultural Plastics (Plastic twine, silage covers, grain bags)
- Appliances
- Metal (includes hot water tanks, scrap metal, bicycles)
- Propane Cylinders (all sizes accepted)
- Tires (no rims)
- Wire (spooled with posts removed)

Garbage Accepted in bins:

- Household garbage (bagged and tied)
- Ashes (boxed or bagged and tied)
- Demolition/Renovation (residential) includes: drywall, roofing shingles, decking, vinyl siding, windows, wood doors, carpet
- Furniture, including beds, chairs, couches, tables, dressers, toilets, basins, sinks, etc.
- Hot tubs (cut into quarters or smaller; able to fit easily in bin)
- Plastics
- Paint cans (empty/dry)
- Wood (treated, painted; cut in lengths to fit in bin)

Metal Accepted (to be placed in metal pile:

- Appliances
- Ballasts
- Barbeques
- Bicycles
- Hot Water Tanks
- Lawn mowers
- Machinery parts
- Motors (gas & electric)
- Pumps
- Rototillers
- Scrap Metal
- Wire (spooled with posts removed)

Wood Accepted (to be placed in wood pile:

- Wood (clean, untreated, burnable)
- Trees & Shrubs (NO STUMPS)

• Not Accepted:

- Animal carcasses, hides or animal parts
- Automobiles
- Batteries (auto)
- Concrete, concrete blocks or rocks
- Compost
- Campers, RV's, boats
- Dynamite
- Flourescent tubes
- Hazardous & bio-hazardous waste
- Liquid waste; oil, oil filters, pesticides, antifreeze, camping fuel or other flammable liquids, any toxic liquids, sewage
- Munitions
- Poisons
- Seeds or grains
- Toxic weeds
- Tree Stumps

Recycling	
Each transfer station may accept different commodities such as newsprint, mixed paper, paint, chemical containers, used oil & filters, e-waste.	No Charge
Town of Millet ³	\$20 per any portion, up to a standard pick-up truck box
	Mattresses \$10.00

¹ All household waste is to be bagged.

² Wire that is not removed from posts and secured in neat rolls will be rejected.

³ Individual loads larger than standard pick-up truck box will not be accepted from Town of Millet Residents.

Mattresses require a separate \$10.00 voucher.

Participating municipalities (i.e. Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach) will also be issued yearly cards of a different colour to clearly identify which municipality they reside in. It will be up to the municipality to ensure proper distribution to their ratepayers.
