

Budget 2021 Highlights:

- The 2021 budget value is \$20.19 Million 5% reduction in Council salaries
- \$500,000 reduction in Gravelling
- \$40,000 reduction in Building Maintenance
- \$50,000 reduction in Mowing
- \$50,000 reduction in Brushing
- \$35,000 reduction in Oiling

- \$500,000 increases in Pood
 - \$500,000 increase in Road Construction
 - \$400,000 increase in Recreation
 - \$142,706 increase in RCMP
 - STARS Air Ambulance donation increased from \$1 to \$1.5 per capita
