Administration:

- Integrated Response Hub Update
 - Council accepted the Hub update as information.
- COVID-19 Update
 - Council accepted the COVID-19 update as information.
- Delegation – Louis Bull Tribe – Land for Prosperity
 - Council accepted the Louis Bull Tribe – Land for Prosperity presentation as information.
- National Day for Truth & Reconciliation Update
 - Council amended Flag Protocol Policy 12.0.17 to include September 30 National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.
 - Council moved to discuss National Day for Truth and Reconciliation at Strategic Planning.
- Telus – Implications for Rural Connectivity
 - Council resolved to send a letter to MP Mike Lake to advise of the County's concerns regarding possible implications for Rural Connectivity.

- Borrowing Bylaw 2021/63

- Borrowing Bylaw 2021/64
 - Council provided three reading to Bylaw 2021/64 to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in the amount of \$296,795.26 for the purpose of the construction of a wastewater system and to carryout a local improvement within the Village Creek Estates Subdivision

 - Council provided three reading to Bylaw 2021/65 to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in the amount of \$290,449.52 for the purpose of the construction of a wastewater system and to carryout a local improvement within the Village of Pigeon Lake Area
