



Council Meeting Highlights

November 9, 2021

Administration:

- Appointment of Municipal Representatives to JEDI
 - Council appointed Councillor L. Carwell to represent and vote on behalf of the County of Wetaskiwin at the JEDI Annual General Meeting. Further, that going forward the JEDI Municipal Representative be appointed at the same time as the JEDI Board Members at the County's Annual Organizational Meeting.
- 2022 Motorcycle Ice Races
 - Council approved the request for the Rocky Motorcycle Club to host the first (2) races of the 2022 Ice Racing Series on Pigeon Lake near Mulhurst Bay on Sunday, January 23, 2022 and Sunday, February 6, 2022, or on the alternative date of Sunday, January 30, 2022, subject to six (6) conditions.
- Bill 73 – Infrastructure Accountability Act
 - Council accepted the particulars concerning Bill 73, formally known as the Infrastructure Accountability Act, as information.
- Meeting Dates January to December 2022
 - Council set meeting dates for January-December 2022 as follows:
 - January 11 & 25
 - February 8 & 22
 - March 8 & 22
 - April 5 & 19
 - May 3, 17 & 31
 - June 14 & 28
- Ambassador Information Session 2022
 - Council accepted the Ambassador Information Session date for March 25, 2022 as information.
- Review of Councillor Code of Conduct Bylaw 2018/05
 - Council provided three readings to the Councillor Code of Conduct Bylaw 2021/71 which outlines the code of conduct for County of Wetaskiwin Elected Officials.
- Appointment of Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Members
 - Council appointed three (3) members to the Subdivision & Development Appeal Board.
- Alberta Regional Railway – Development of New Travel System
 - Council supported, in principle, support to Alberta Railway to enable passenger rail to get on track by 2027.

Planning and Development:

- Development Monthly Report for the Month of October:
 - 35 applications received
 - 40 permits completed
 - 455 applications completed to date (January 1 – October 31)
 - 171 Approach and Rural Address Inspections (year to date)
- Third Subdivision Extension for RW/18/21
 - Council approved a twelve (12) month extension for Subdivision RW/18/21 (MPS File #20-R-179).
- Subdivision Application RW/21/17
 - Council approved proposed Subdivision Application RW/21/17 (MPS File # 21-R-411) within NE 16-45-27-W4M, subject to four (4) conditions.
- Intermunicipal Development Plans – Intent to Rescind
 - Council accepted the particulars concerning the proposed rescinding of the Intermunicipal Development Plans (IDPs) between Camrose County and the County of Wetaskiwin, as well as

Ponoka County and the County of Wetaskiwin, including the scheduling of Public Hearings to do so, as information.

Protective Services:

- Peace Officer Program Review – Audit
 - Council accepted the Peace Officer Program Review Audit Report for the County of Wetaskiwin as information.

Public Works:

- Alberta Transportation – Highway 2 Access Relocation
 - Council approved the joint collaboration between the County of Wetaskiwin and Alberta Transportation to remove a private residential access connecting to Highway 2 and safely relocate its access point to a developed County roadway.
- Speed Rate Bylaw 2021/53
 - Council provided three readings to Bylaw 2021/53 to add Section I Hamlets and Subdivisions
 - Hiland View Subdivision 30 km/hr
 - Heritage Estates Subdivision 30 km/hr
 - Dorchester Ranch 30 km/hr
- Range Road 11 South Paving Local Improvement Plans
 - Council tabled the Local Improvement Plan for the upgrade and paving of Range Road 11 south of Highway 13 proposing to raise funds totaling \$1,595,000.00 proportioned between two hundred and seventy-one (271) properties as presented in accordance with Section 393(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*.
 - Council approved the Local Improvement Plan for the upgrade and paving of Range Road 11 south of Highway 13 proposing to raise funds totaling \$175,000.00 as it pertains to Roll #285800 as presented in accordance with Section 393(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*.
 - Council approved the Local Improvement Plan for the upgrade and paving of Range Road 11 south of Highway 13 proposing to raise funds totaling \$230,000.00 as it pertains to Roll #285801 as presented in accordance with Section 393(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*.
- Road Allowance Lease Renewals
 - Council approved the road allowance lease renewals for a further three (3) year term, in accordance with Road Allowance Closure for Lease or Sale Policy #12.0.4.
