



Council Meeting Highlights

October 18, 2022

Administration:

- Request for Sale/Purchase County Land – Plan 8221631; Block 1; Lot 14
 - Council approved to proceed with listing the subject property legally described as Plan 8221631, Block 1, Lot 14 with the realtor, as per policy 12.0.16 “Request for Sale of County Property” and allow Administration to sell the property at the highest possible price.
- 2022 Audit Contract Increase
 - Council moved that the 2022 Audit Contract be tabled to the November 2, 2022 meeting.

 - Council provided three readings to Bylaw 2022/56 for the purpose of imposing a local improvement tax for Grandview Meadows Local Wastewater Collection Lines.

- 2022 Third Quarter Year to Date Budget Variance Analysis
 - Council accepted the 2022 Third Quarter Year to Date Budget Variance Report as presented.

Planning and Development:

- September 2022 Development Report
 - 2 Commercial Permit Applications.

- Direct Control (DC) Development Permit Application – Wizard Water Ski Club
 - Council approved Development Permit D21/289, subject to 20 conditions.
- Fourth Subdivision Extension for 1634715 Alberta Ltd.
 - Council approved a fourth twelve (12) month extension for Subdivision RW /18/21 until July 18, 2023, as per Section 7.1.1 of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 Land Use Bylaw 2017/48.
- Proposed subdivision within SW 33-46-6-W5M
 - Council approved proposed subdivision within SW 33-46-6-W5M, subject to twelve (12) conditions.
- Proposed subdivision within SE & SW 5-48-23-W4M & NE 32-47-23-W4M
 - Council approved proposed subdivision within SE & SW 5-48-23-W4M and NE 32-47-23-W4M, subject to eight (8) conditions.

Protective Services

- September 2022 Protective Services Report
 - During the month of September CPO's traveled 7,925 Km's.
 - Protective Services received a complaint for bales being hauled unsecured in Division 1. CPO located the vehicle, fully loaded and travelling above the speed limit. CPO confirmed the load was completely unsecured and conducted a traffic stop. CPO further found the young male only

possessed a class 5 GDL operator's license, the vehicle required a class 1. Charges sent registered owner for allowing the offenses to occur.

- Peace Officers conducted traffic enforcement on Hwy 22 near Alder Flats. 2 violations issued to a commercial vehicle speeding and improper cargo securement.
- Peace Officers assisted with traffic control for the Terry Fox run at the Pipestone School.
- This past September the Bylaw Enforcement Department saw an increase in closed files from 11 to 28 when compared with August.

Public Works

- September 2022 Public Works Report
 - Range Road 11 (Black Bull Rd) Pavement Upgrade (from Hwy 13 to Cavallo Ridge Resort) is primarily complete with two lifts of pavement.
 - The micro-surfacing project in Buck Lake and area is complete.
 - Three (3) Bridge Replacements in Divisions 1 and 6 have been awarded to Prairie Erector's International Inc. Work is primarily complete on RR 43 north of Winfield on BF 83245. Work on BF 83244 south of Winfield is underway and should be substantially complete by October 20th. Work on BF 78867 east of the City of Wetaskiwin will begin in mid to late October.
 - Work on the Cavallo Ridge Resort lift station is complete.
 - Culvert replacements occurred at various locations county-wide.
 - Ongoing signage installation, garbage pick-up, hand-brushing, dangerous tree removal, etc.
