

A Public Hearing will be held on July 16, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. All Public Hearings are open to the public, and attendance, either in person or virtually, is encouraged. Written and verbal comments may be given at the Public Hearing.

Purpose of the Public Hearing: In December 2019, the Clearwater County/County of Wetaskiwin Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) was approved to comply with the *Municipal Government Act* (MGA). Section 631(2) of the MGA no longer requires municipalities to have an IDP if they mutually agree that one is not required.

In a collaborative effort, Clearwater County and the County of Wetaskiwin have tentatively agreed that their respective municipalities' Municipal Development Plan and Land Use Bylaws will fulfill the core functions and benefits of an IDP. As a result, both municipalities are proposing to repeal the Clearwater County/County of Wetaskiwin IDP.
