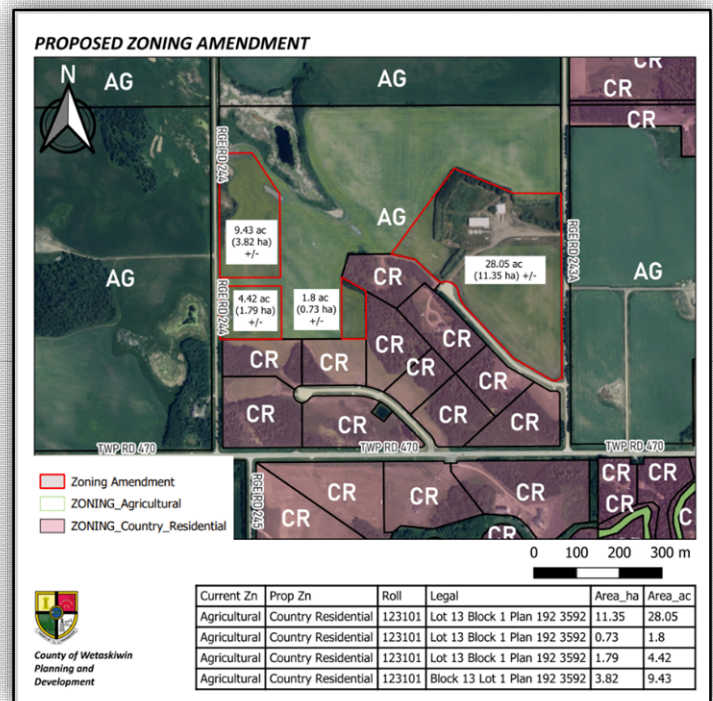

A **Public Hearing** will be held on November 26, 2024 at 9:15 a.m. All Public Hearings are open to the public and attendance either in person or virtually is encouraged. Written and verbal comments may be given at the Public Hearing.

Purpose of the Public Hearing: The Council of the County of Wetaskiwin No. 10 has received an application to amend its Land Use Bylaw by redistricting part of the following land within **N ½ SW 4-47-24-W4M Plan 1923592, Block 1, Lot 13** (as shown on the accompanying map) from Agricultural (AG) District to Country Residential (CR) District.

The purpose of the rezoning is to facilitate the subdivision of 10 lots, as outlined in the Area Structure Plan, adopted in October 2024. A copy of the Country Residential (CR) District can be obtained from the County Office, or by emailing wpermits@county10.ca.



Persons wishing to provide written submissions or make a presentation should note the following deadlines and requirements:

- Persons claiming to be affected may attend, without prior notification, to make their views known by presenting/speaking at the Public Hearing.
- Please note that the Council Meeting will be in progress, beginning at 9:00 a.m., and public attending are asked to enter and be seated in the gallery with minimal disruption.
- Written comments will form part of the submission and be presented at the Hearing.
- Submissions must be related to the topic of the Public Hearing.
- Council may determine speaking time limits.
